President Shavkat Mirziyoyev: New centre will serve for Islamic culture development



President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev has visited the Imam Bukhari memorial complex in Samarqand Region.

The Head of State inspected a project of construction of two and three-storey affordable apartment houses for people in Payarig District.



The President also visited the field of the "Topolos" farm in Payariq District, held conversations with farmers and peasants and found out about crop yields.

President Shavkat Mirziyoyev presided over a gathering attended by governors and officials of the region.
