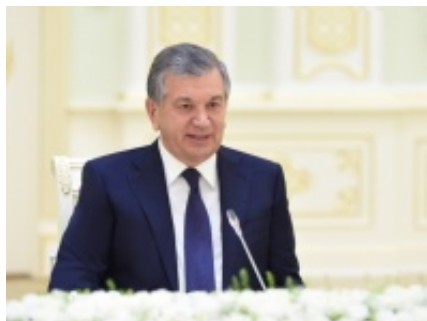


President of the Republic of Uzbekistan received the Head of the Chechen Republic
