

On telephone conversation of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the President of Turkmenistan



On November 13, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev had a telephone conversation with the President of Turkmenistan Gurbanguly Berdimuhamedov.
