

President Shavkat Mirziyoyev attends the Arab Islamic American Summit



The Arab Islamic American Summit took place in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.

Heads of member-states of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation, the US, Secretary-Generals of the UN, the League of Arab States, the Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf attended the summit.

Saudi Arabia's King Salman bin Abdulaziz al-Saud, welcoming the participants of the summit, underlined that their partaking has an important significance for increasing the prestige of this forum.
